42. Section 1. Officers. The officers of BTU shall be the executive officers and executive
43. board members specified in the BTU Constitution

45. Section 2. Eligibility. Officer candidates shall have been a member in good standing
46. of a BTU bargaining unit for ~~two~~ **five** consecutive years at time of nomination
47. and shall remain a member in good standing throughout their term of office.

49. Section 3. Nominations

50. A. A candidate seeking election as an executive officer ~~or an executive board member~~
51. shall nominated by a signed petition of ~~ten (10)~~ **fifty (50)** members in good standing of a
52. BTU bargaining unit **and served on the executive board for a minimum of one full term.**

53. **B. A candidate seeking election as an executive board member shall be nominated by a**
54. **signed petition of twenty-five (25) members in good standing of a BTU bargaining unit**
55. **and served as a school/site BTU Steward for at least three years (one full term).**

56. ~~B. C.~~ A candidate seeking election as a TSP/CSP/ESP vice president ~~or a designated~~
57. ~~EP/TSP/CSP/ESP executive board member~~ shall be nominated by signed petition
58. from ~~ten (10)~~ **fifty (50)** members in good standing of the respective unit **and served for**
59. **one full term on the executive board.**

60. ~~C. D.~~ Nominations shall be open in the month of January for a period of fifteen (15) days.
